Here are some ideas to get you thinking about what type of activity hours to include on YOUR fraternal survey.

Boy Scouts, Visiting the Sick, Picnic Activity with Ruth Eason (4 hours), AA County Fair Car Parking Fundraiser (1 shift = 4 hours), Pregnancy Walk/Run Parking (2 hours), GBIA Fireworks Parking (4 hours), Intellectually Disabled Campaign – Tootsie Rolls (hours at Annapolis Boat Shows, or total you collected / \$12 hour) Sunday Bingo (Each Team Member * 6 hours/Sunday * 8 Sundays/Year = 48 hours minimum) North County Emergency Outreach Network – NCEON, Activities for Children (Easter, Halloween, Christmas, Fishing Derby), Donating Blood, Our Daily Bread, Habitat for Humanity, Christmas in April, Prayer of Rosary for Sick and Deceased, Usher, Eucharistic Minister, Lecture, Cantor, Religious Education Aid/Teacher, Fundraisers (BINGO) at church and parochial schools (Manhattan After Dark, Haunted Trail, etc), Cleanup of the council home, assisting neighbors, coaching youth sports.

The above suggestions are just to get you thinking.

Remember to include your planning hours too.
